1. **HOST** Portland State University & the Columbia Gorge Racing Association
2. **RULES** The regatta will be governed by the ICSA Procedural Rules; the College Dinghy Class Rules; the rules of the CFJ Class regarding Collegiate FJ's (except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions, or the ICSA Procedural Rules); by the and Laser Class Association rules, and by the Sailing Instructions.
3. **FORMAT** This will be a non-rotational, FOUR division regatta, with C and D divisions being sailed in Lasers. C and D divisions are not required to compete in this event and all schools who cannot field Laser sailors are still highly encouraged to attend (and, for that matter, schools that can *only* field Laser divisions are also encouraged to attend).
4. **BOATS & ENTRY** Limited Laser charters will be available with a maximum limit of 1 per team. That said, we strongly encourage everyone to bring their own Lasers if at all possible. Please respond ASAP if you would like to charter a Laser.
